



All Things New

Psalm 102:25 *In the beginning you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. Like clothing you will change them and they will be discarded. But you remain the same, and Your years will never come to an end.*

Refers to Jesus (Hebrews 1:10)

The One who was seated on the throne declared, "I am making all things new!" Revelation 21:5 ('new' here is Gr. kainos – see below)

Two Greek Words for "New" – Two Concepts in New Testament

1. **Neos:** New in time, recent, young (1 Timothy 3:6 neophyte; 5:1) The New Wine of the Kingdom Luke 5:38-39 (N)

2. **Kainos:** Also New in quality, unused, fresh, retaining its original power and vitality; i.e. what is of a different nature from what is old - not worn or wearing out (as in Psalm 102:26; Hebrews 1:10-12) The New or Unused Wineskins Luke 5:38 (K) The "neos wine" is that which is going through the process of fermentation – hence "new in time". What is important about the "kainos" wineskins is that they have the quality of being new – soft, supple and flexible to handle the pressures of fermentation.

The Anticipation of Newness

Ezekiel 36:26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you.

Jeremiah 31:31 "The time is coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel..."

1. Put law in minds and hearts
2. Be their God
3. People will know God
4. Because He will forgive them.

Below is a list of characteristics and qualities that are declared "New!" The letter following a passage identifies it as 'N' for neos, and 'K' for kainos)

1. **New Work:** I will do something new... Isaiah 43:19 (K Septuagint)
2. **New Creation** 2 Corinthians 5:17 (K); Galatians 6:15 (K)
3. **New and Living Way** opened for us through the curtain, Christ's body, Hebrews 10:20 (K) New in both time and quality
4. **New Covenant** Heb 12:24 (N) Jeremiah 31:31 (K)
2 Cor 3:6 (K) Not of letter, but of Spirit Heb 8:8 powerful (K)
Heb 9:15 As effective, sets free, not just forgiven (K)
5. **New Fulfillment & Celebration in a New Kingdom** "Drink it new with you in the kingdom of God (K) Mt.13:52; 26:29
6. **New Life** John 10:10 I have come that they might have life and have it beyond expectations. Eternal Life John 3:16;
7. **New Birth** – "Born Again" or "Born from Above" John 3:3-8
1 Peter 1:3; 2 Cor 4:16 by the Spirit.

8. **New Self or New You** (Neos) is constantly being **Renewed** (Kainos) Ephesians 4:24 (K); Colossians 3:10 (N,K)
9. **New Hope** – A Living Hope. We were without hope; now in Christ we have been called to a new hope. Eph 1:18; 2:12ff; 1 Pet 3:15 Always be prepared to give the reason for your hope. Col 1:18 "hope of glory"
10. **New Heart** Cleansed with new motivation to love God Eze 36:26(K)
11. **New Spirit with New Power** "You will receive power when the Spirit comes upon you" Acts 1:8; Eph 1:19ff; Ezekiel 36:26-2 (K) "My Spirit"
12. **New Way of Living** (K) Rom 6:4 (K) "live in newness of life!" Eph 5:1
13. **New Way of Thinking or Worldview** and Daily **Renewal** Eph 4:23(N)
14. **New Commandment: Christ's Love** John 13:34; 1 John 2:7-8 (K)
15. **New "Man"** ("body of Christ"- Church) (K) Eph 2:15; 4:13
16. **New Loaf** – New Purity, New as a people 1 Cor. 5:7 (N)
17. **New Name** of Jesus Revelations 3:12 (K)
18. **New Name** given to us Rev 2:17 (K)
19. **New Song** Psalm 40:1-3; Rev 5:9 Song of the Redeemed (K)
20. **New Heaven and Earth** where righteousness lives (K)
21. **New Jerusalem** Rev 21:2; 9-10 (K) "the bride, the wife of the Lamb"
22. Under **New Management** (1 Cor 8:6) providing the following:
23. **New Standing:** In Grace and Known by God Rom 5:2; Gal 4:9
24. **New Seating:** Seated with Jesus in the Heavens Eph 2:6
25. **New Service** Romans 7:4-6 (K) (It is important to see that we still serve, but it's in the **newness of the Spirit of God**.)
26. **New Choices** - We can go on living according to the old patterns, but when we do what are we saying? Romans 8:14
27. **New Eyes** – a new way of seeing ourselves and others.
1 John 2:8; 2 Corinthians 5:7; 16-17 All is "new".
28. **Re-New-al** – We are continually Renewed in Christ 2 Cor 4:16 (K)
29. And when we walk in all God's Newness the **Results are New** too!
**Always fresh, always powerful, always relevant,
Never old, never stale, never impotent or irrelevant.**

Sometimes Scripture calls us to be babes and children. Infants regarding sin and evil – innocent and lacking skill, ability, and cunning. Children in humble faith and trust, without the skepticism, cynicism or mistrust that life can bring. Luke 18:16-17

Sometimes it calls us to grow up. Become mature in our faith, remaining steadfast. Mature in our perceptions, discernment and understanding. Mature in our skill and ability to walk in God's Spirit. 1 Corinthians 14:20

New Commitment to Pray – How new things get revealed Jmes 5:17 1 Kng 18

New in quality – tested, but always fresh Psalm 92:12-15
